

# WIP - Désinstaller des modules en masse

S'il est possible nativement d'installer des modules "en masse", ce n'est pas le cas pour les désinstallations. Voici une astuce pour pouvoir le faire :

Attention cela va désinstaller les modules sans vous montrer les modules qui en dépendent et qui seront aussi désinstallé. A utiliser avec précaution !

1. Installer le module `mass_editing` et créer une opération en lot comme ci-dessous.

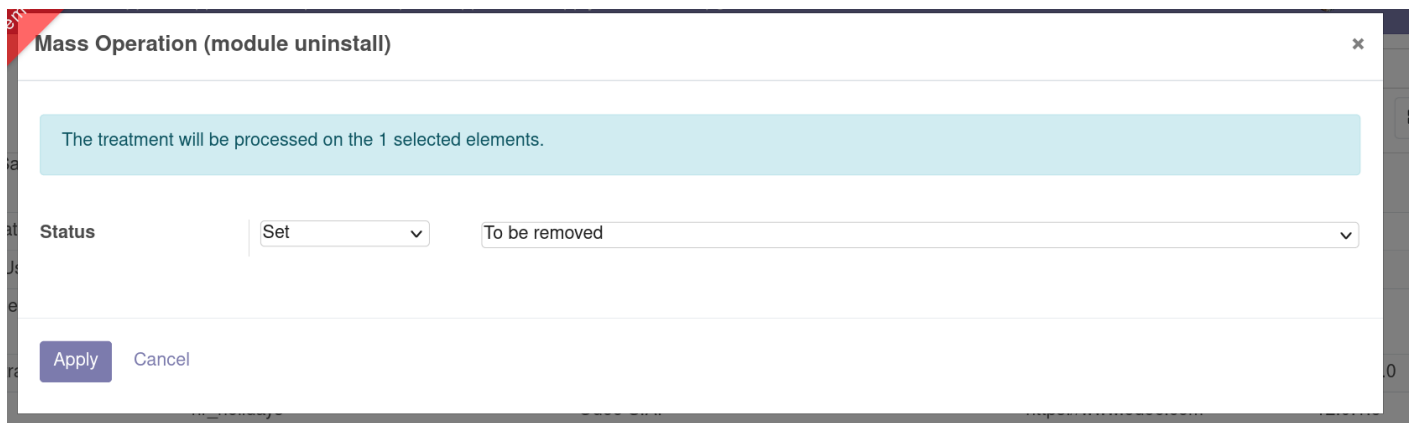
2. Aller dans les applications en vue liste, et sélectionnez les applications à désinstaller.

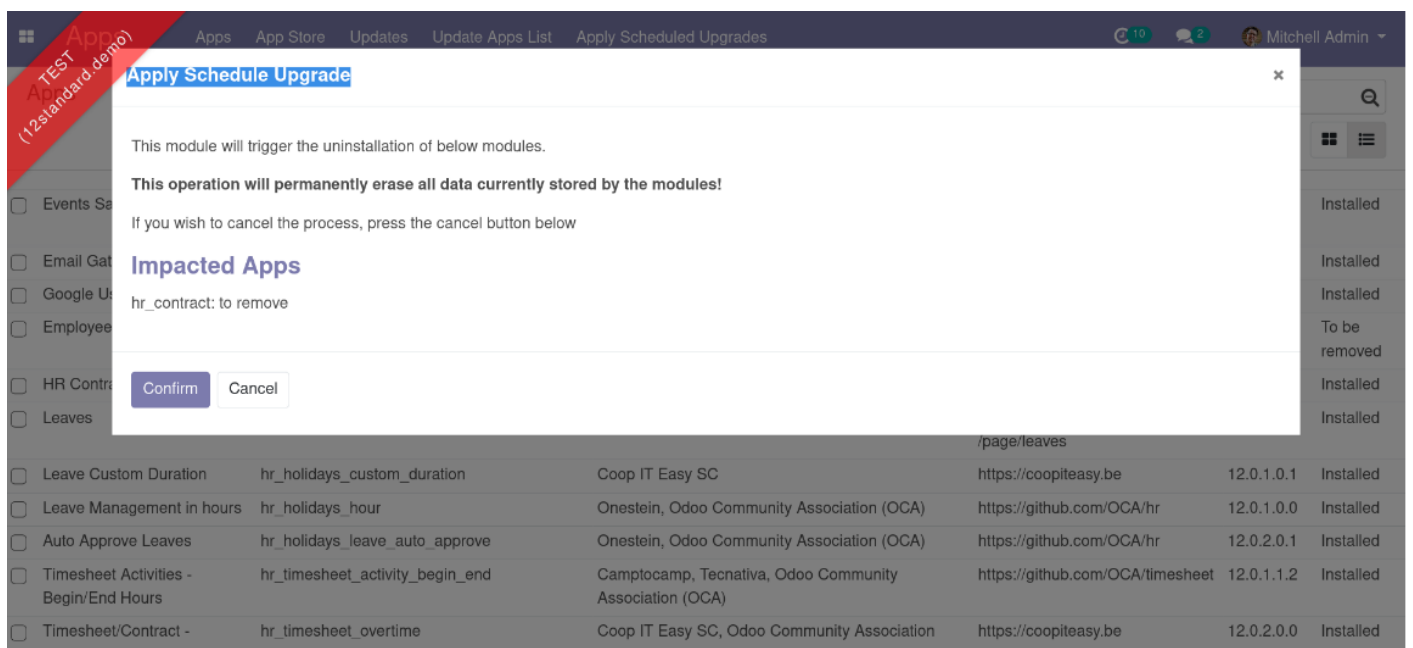
